- **3.** Policy: What can governments and society do to promote environmental awareness and limit global warming? Join the discourse with *Tomas Kåberger (Swedish Energy Agency)* and *Sándor Kerekes (Corvinus University)*.
- **4. Thinking about the Future:** What should it mean? Bracing for impact or preparing for the unexpected? Meet *Dennis Meadows* and *Sándor Fülöp (Ombudsman for Future Generations)* and discuss what we can do now to prepare for the future.
